This programme helps develop leadership skills and confidence. It includes strategies to lead and manage others and to improve teaching and learning.

As part of the programme you will be expected to complete a small research project in your own school.

- Develop ways of meeting the needs of your pupils through pupil-centred planning
- Understand the role of data in the SEND context
